

Effective Tricks To Clean Your Windows Like A Pro



Wait until it's cloudy

If the sunbeams dry the cleaning solution before you wipe it, you'll find window streaks. Wait for dry, cloudy days to clean your windows!



Don't skimp on window cleaner

The cleaner you spray on the glass it's supposed to dissolve and help you remove dirt. If you skimp on glass cleaner, you'll end up with window streaks. Spritz it generously!



Wipe one side horizontally and the other vertically

Cleaning a window is more challenging if you don't know which side of the window is streaked! Spot window streaks faster by wiping one side horizontally and the other side vertically.



Use a microfiber towel

Paper towels just aren't made for window cleaning. Some people use newspapers (and it works!), but using a high-quality, reusable microfiber towel is the best way to go!



Vacuum the windows first

The less dirt you clean, the less likely you'll have a muddy mess. Don't rely entirely on your glass cleaner and elbow grease; vacuum your windows before wiping them!
